Dear Friends,

At my ordination, now 33 years ago (where does the time go?), the most profound moment for me was during the Litany of the Saints. As I lay on the sanctuary floor and the choir sang the names of the great saints, followed by "pray for us," I had the overwhelming sense that I was putting my life in God's hands and that the saints would be there to help me keep my promises as well as all those who I loved and were already with God.

None of us get through this life alone. I certainly have not. When I opened my eyes after the laying on of hands at my ordination, I saw that I was surrounded by my brothers in community, my fellow Missionaries of the Precious Blood. They too would be a significant part of the rest of my life, my second family. I have leaned on them at times over the years, and I think they know that they can lean on me.

One of the things that our candidates who are studying for the priesthood or to be a religious brother come to understand over the years is that the "bond of charity" that we talk about in our Community statutes is a very real thing. When we become Missionaries of the Precious Blood, we pledge to be there for each other, to support each other in good times and bad, and to be brothers to each other in a very real sense.

As you know, family life changes and evolves over the years, and the same is true of religious life. I have a completely different understanding, which I hope is more broad and deep, of what the "bond of charity" really means than when I was a young priest newly ordained. I'm in the midst of my second term as provincial director, charged with providing leadership for my C.PP.S. brothers. When I was young, I would have seen this job as a real pain! And there are times when it is. There are a lot of meetings, phone calls, planning sessions and other obligations that you might not immediately connect with a life in ministry.
