The Litany of Loreto, so called because of its use at the shrine of the Holy House in Loreto, dates back to the Middle Ages. It was approved for use by the whole Church by Pope Sixtus V in 1587. At that time, it was established as the only Marian Litany approved for public use. Other Marian Litanies may of course be prayed privately. Over the centuries, popes have, from time to time, added invocations to the Litany. The last pope to do so before Pope Francis was Pope St. John 1980 and 1995.

The litany consist of a series of titles Mary, followed by the request that she titles and invocation of Mary used in toward our Blessed Mother and invite her exalted privilege, her holiness, her and her queenly majesty. In her is the virtue and the glory that awaits us in.
